

# K.I.D. Ministry – Getting Started is Easy!

- 1. Promote K.I.D. to your Senior Pastor, Potential Leaders and Parents**
  - a. Pray for God's will to be done.
  - b. Share K.I.D. promotional items, contact us for items available.
  - c. Recruit a prayer team to intercede for the children, families and future K.I.D. leaders in your church.
  
- 2. Get Approval to Recruit a K.I.D. Leadership Team**
  - a. Confirm that your senior pastor will attend K.I.D. University training.
  - b. Recruit 3 additional team members.
  - c. Share K.I.D. ministry descriptions with potential leaders, these descriptions are contained the in the Information/Registration Guide.
  - d. Conduct congregation and church board surveys and record your results on the K.I.D. University Registration Form
  
- 3. Register the Leadership Team for K.I.D. University**
  - a. Submit your K.I.D. Team Registration Form including survey results and payment.
  - b. Attend K.I.D. University training.
  
- 4. Promote K.I.D. to your Congregation**
  - a. Pastor schedules a four-week sermon series (*provided at K.I.D. University*). This sermon series communicates the central importance of discipling children to Jesus.
  - b. Challenge the congregation to equip and support parents as the primary disciplers of their children.
  
- 5. Launch your K.I.D. Ministry (*Sabbath of the 4<sup>th</sup> sermon*)**
  - a. Introduce the K.I.D. Vision to your entire congregation.
  - b. Invite participants from other active K.I.D. ministries to share testimonies.
  - c. Invite members to attend an orientation meeting on Sabbath afternoon.
    - Pray together for the families represented in your church and community.
    - Present an overview of the *Footprints* curriculum.
    - Establish class leaders, meeting times and places.
    - Provide information and sign-up sheets for upcoming classes.

- 7. Begin *Footprints for Kids* after *Footprints for Parents and Mentors*.**
